DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Minutes of the 45th meeting held on Sunday 13th October 1996.

Present: A.W.Bond (Chairman); M.C.Wright; J.Soper; M.S.Miller (Manager).

- 1. Apologies for absence: none. All present.
- 2. Minutes of the last meeting (1.9.96): Approved.
- 3. Matters Arising: Covered below.
- 4. Red Lion: The building estimate was reviewed and adjusted ("Re-erection of Red Lion, Sept 1995, based on original estimate dated 1989, reviewed 13.10.96"), appendix 1. Estimates for the winter budget had included £11,000 to fit the roof. However it became clear in the discussion that there was still approximately 150 of the original December 1995 estimate of 200 man-days still needed before the walls would reach the required height (i.e. 50 man-days achieved in the last nine months).

At this rate, unless more resource was used, it would not be possible to put on the roof until the winter budget 1999/2000, and the building site and scaffolding would remain in place until then. This was over double the time frame estimated at the last meeting only six weeks ago.

It was agreed that, including the carry-forward, a total of £4500 would be sufficient for the winter period, and it would be recommended that additional resource be allocated to advance progress to enable the roof to be installed during the summer budget 1997. The target was an unglazed but waterproof shell by October 1997. The Manager would identify what other winter work would have to be deferred to achieve this target.

Action: MSM A further £85,000 would then be required before the building could be used.

There had been complaints that the building work could be seen from the entrance road and should be screened, and it was agreed this would be reviewed.

Action: MSM & JS

- 5. Other items for the Winter Budget:
- a. Wheelchair route to Town End, for access to Berlin 3006. Precise details to be reviewed with the 3006 project group (appendix 2). In essence, ramps would be needed and kerbs realigned. It was emphasised that the Tramway Period Street should not be compromised by these alterations.

 Action: MCW
- b. More Tarmac: Around the public entrance; the first bay of the car park; the slope to the Fleamarket. The proposal to tarmac Field House car park was not agreed.

 Action: MSM
- c. Footpath Fleamarket to Wakebridge. Consideration required on fencing and gates, a steady stream of visitors now appears every day at Cabin Crossing and expects to be able to board a tram.

 Action: MSM
- d. Bookshop awning. New signs would be required. In view of the unauthentic repaints earlier this year, it was agreed that their design and colour must be approved by the Committee prior to repainting.

 Action: MSM
- 6. AOB: New shop signs had appeared on the side and end of the Forge Bookshop. It was agreed that they were of a totally inappropriate design, not Tramway Period and should be removed. It was agreed that the Collections Management Committee be asked to define a suitable set of fonts of the correct Tramway Period using computer-aided design.

 Action: AWB
